

Cross-Country Gold!!!!

We are sure that you will be as delighted and proud as we are in school with the phenomenal success of our Year 4, 5 & 6 athletes last week. We are so proud of the 48 children who took part in the Truro Area cross country races at Penair School last Friday.

It is an incredible achievement that our boys & girls teams for Years 4, 5 & 6 won gold across the board in the team competition element for the six races. Almost 50% of these athletes have now qualified for the Peninsula Semi Finals on 20th and we have our fingers crossed for further future success.

Lent 2018

We are busy in school getting ready for the start of Lent 2018 . Our Lenten theme for this year is **Give & Take**. Within the Give element of Give & Take, we have been looking at:

Give Out: The children know that they can give out some practical love in Lent. Some of them might even be inspired by the 40 Cans for Lent Challenge. Families (or a group of families) might like to collect one can a day during Lent & then donate the 40 cans to Truro Food Bank. Or they might like to gather 40 books/games/toys and donate them to a local charity shop.

Give Up: The children know that they could give up something sweet or give up a little time on their ipad or xbox or give up a habit that may be a little annoying to

Give More: The children also know that instead of giving something up, they could take something on. Do they ever think about all the people who serve us in one way or another each day? The postman/woman, the rubbish collector, the lollipop man/woman, their club leader and many more. They could treat any one of them to a little something as a way of showing their gratitude.

We have been exploring with the children that the Lenten message of trying a little self-sacrifice is not just a Christian message but is true of many faiths around the world as well as for people of no faith. We remind the children that it does not matter if we Follow God or Follow Good as long as we try to follow the Golden Rule: Do unto others as you would have them do unto you.

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday which falls during halfterm this year. We hope that you all have a lovely Pancake Tuesday and that you are inspired on Ash Wednesday to try a little extra Give & Take over the 40 days of Lent.




Capoeira Club
