# Attendance and Punctuality

I just wanted to say thank you to all our families for your continued support in terms of getting your children to school every day and on time. Our overall attendance rate for Autumn 1 was 97.6% which is a great achievement. Thank you.

Every half-term Rachel Jarman, our Education Welfare Officer (EWO), has a meeting with me to review our attendance and punctuality for that half-term. Naturally she is impressed with our overall attendance rate so far this year. When she looked at our Late Book, to check our overall pupil punctuality, she was a bit surprised to see unusually high levels of pupil lateness on Wednesday and Thursday of this week.

We realise that there are a variety of issues that can contribute to pupil lateness:

- Some parents mentioned that traffic, and parking in and around Bodmin Road, is worse than ever. We do appreciate that this appears to be the case and that it can be incredibly frustrating for parents but if that is now the new reality, then it may be the case that certain families have to start their mornings five minutes earlier to compensate for this. Our EWO has asked us to politely challenge those parents who repeatedly give traffic as the reason for their child's lateness.
- Some parents, whose children have been late, have expressed their frustrations that the school driveway is always congested in the mornings and car park spaces are not easily available for Infant parents because so many Infant parents are choosing to wait and wave to their children in the playground rather than leave and free up the spaces for other parents to use. Understandably some of these parents did not feel it was fair that their child was then marked as late.

If any parent feels that this is the cause of their child's lateness, then please record that in the Late Book. I do check it regularly and if this is a recurring issue, then I will bring it to the Resources Committee to discuss the effectiveness of our dropping off arrangements.

Whatever the reason for your child's lateness, we are legally required to monitor all pupil lateness. We are not doing so to try and catch parents out or to make them feel bad first thing in the morning. We try to be as polite and welcoming as possible to all late comers and we ask that parents respond in the same way to us.

After an EWO visit, it is often necessary for me to contact some parents, mostly by letter, to inform them if we have some concerns regarding attendance. If you do receive such a letter, then I hope that you will make an appointment to see me so we can see what we can do together to improve your child's attendance. However this time, I am delighted that I will also be sending out some improvement letters too.

I will be notifying some parents where we have concerns about recurring poor punctuality. Again we are not trying to upset or annoy parents and I hope that they will want to meet with me to see if we can help in resolving any issues.

# Use of photos

Class 3W did a wonderful job today with our first class assembly of the year to parents. Seeing parents in the hall prompted us to remind you about our policy in relation to photographs being taken of our pupils while in school. We do allow parents, legal guardians, and family members to take images of their child participating in school activities but it is based on the collective commitment of all parents that any photos taken can only be used for family and personal use.

We need to make parents aware that when any parent or guardian takes a photo of their child in a school event, there is always the possibility that the child may be photographed with a friend, or that there may be other children inadvertently in the background. However we work on a basis of mutual trust that these photos are only ever used for personal and domestic use and that parents never upload images of their child, where other children are also in the photo, onto any social media websites etc.

If any parent does not want their child's image to appear in the school newsletter, website or other forms of communication, then please let us know and we will add them to our Restrictions Register.
