**IMPORTANT INFORMATION - See overleaf**

Should your child wish to join a club, please complete one of the permission slips attached and then ask your child to return this to the teacher organising the club or the school office. Children will only be allowed to join a club if a permission slip is completed. All clubs will continue throughout the term unless otherwise stated.

**PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:**

- Places for clubs run by the school will not be issued on a first come, first served basis. If there are more children than spaces for a particular club, the leader in charge will consider the names and year groups of all the children who have signed up:
  - Where a club is open to a year group or to a number of year groups, the leader will seek to ensure that there is a balanced allocation of places across the relevant classes.
  - Where it is a new club, the leader may decide to start with "picking names out of a hat"
  - Where it is an established club, leaders may decide to use a combination of selection criteria i.e. allocate some spaces for existing members, reserve a proportion of places each term to allow some new pupils to be able to join
  - Where it is a small club with a limited number of places available, leaders may operate a "rota" allocation across the term or the year
  - A child may apply for a place in a club where the school knows that he/she has a specific talent that might benefit from engagement in that club at that particular time or where the child has a particular need that could be supported by attending that club. In that event, the leader would discuss that with the class teacher or a senior leader before making a decision about the allocation of places.

The primary aim of each club is to promote pupil enjoyment and engagement within that specific activity as well as raising and maintaining high levels of pupil participation. We do maintain a secondary focus on those pupils/families who may engage in no club activity.

The majority of our club leaders offer their services on a voluntary basis and invest a lot of time not just in the running of the clubs but in ensuring that pupil participation in these clubs is fair, equitable and as objective as possible. You have always been very supportive of our endeavours in providing a wide range of clubs across the year groups. Whilst we always welcome parental feedback on our clubs, as we do on all aspects of school life, we do not expect or ask our leaders to have to routinely explain the reasons for their allocation of individual places to parents. Where a parent may have a query, then club leaders will always welcome the opportunity to discuss this with you. If you have a continuing concern, then Mrs Giblett, Mrs Power or Mr Galler are always available to meet with you.

- Places on paid clubs, will operate on a first come first served basis.
- If your child will not be attending a club for a particular reason, but they have been at school that day it is a requirement, for Health & Safety reasons, that you let either their teacher or the office know. There have been occasions where a child has not attended a club session without the club leader being notified, and the school has then had to engage in a lengthy process at the end of the school day, with many staff involved, to locate where that child has actually gone. This can be both distressing and stressful for all involved. Leaving a message on the school answer phone is acceptable, like you currently do for school absence.

Please note that if a child has signed up for a club, they must commit to every session unless a valid reason is provided. Irregular attendance could result in your child's place being offered to another child on the waiting list who is very keen to participate in the club.
- We do expect children to behave well in clubs with the same standards and expectations that we maintain during the normal school day. Where there may be issues relating to your child's behaviour, then the club leader will discuss this with you and work together to resolve. Where such behaviour continues and begins to impact on pupil safety and the club's outcomes, then it may be that your child may no longer be able to attend that particular club.
- All children will be dismissed from after school clubs from the Main Entrance.
- Please ensure that all children are picked up on time. Repeated, prolonged lateness could result in your child no longer being able to attend that particular club.
