Cornwall School Games

On Friday 29th June, 50 of our children went to Penryn College and the surrounding areas for this year's Cornwall School Games finals day. They had worked hard throughout the year to qualify for this fantastic event and were up against the very best in the county. It was an absolutely superb day of sport and an amazing experience for the children. It all kicked off with an impressive opening ceremony before the children went to their respective locations to compete. The children all enjoyed themselves and did incredibly well!

Our golf team won gold, to be crowned the top team in Cornwall for the second year running. Our Year 5 & 6 QuadKids athletics team won silver, as did our Year 3 & 4 tennis team. Our Year 2 & 3 girls football team and our Year 5 & 6 gymnastics team also both won bronze medals. Our Year 4 & 5 girls football team were 4th in the county and our Year 3 & 4 dance team were 6th.

After the final result for the year came in yesterday, we have ended up 2nd out of all of the primary schools in Cornwall in the School Games medal table. We have won the same number of medals and actually more golds than winners Mount Hawke but miss out on top spot by just one point!

We also finished second in the county in the Helen Glover Primary Champions Race.

What a fantastic achievement!

I would like to take this opportunity to say a massive thank you to everyone who has made this fantastic year of sport possible.

Our amazing staff and parents have given up so much time and energy running clubs and taking the children to countless events throughout the year.

Here's to 2018-2019!
