Music Lessons

KS2 children have the opportunity to learn an instrument. Lessons are provided by

peripatetic music teachers who come in once a week and provide lessons during normal school time in the following:- violin, brass, woodwind and guitar (some instruments can be hired).

Lessons cost approx £5 - £5.50 per lessons and are taught in small groups. There are subsidies available and individual lessons can sometimes be taught for a higher cost

All of the peripatetic teachers are specialist music teachers and have performed live demonstrations in school for the children over the past few weeks so they have a chance to see and hear some of the instruments.

Forms are available from the school office for any children who would like to start in September.
