Safeguarding

We have been a little surprised and concerned this week to see that a few of our Infant parents are leaving their children at the Infant Gate in the morning unsupervised before staff come on duty at 8.30. All Infant children should be supervised by an adult until they are handed over at the right time to the staff who are on duty. It may be that the parents in question feel that their children are ok to be left along with the other parents and children who may be waiting at the gate before 8.30. Unless a parent has directly handed their child over to the care of another parent, they must never assume that their child will be supervised in their absence.

We will be speaking directly to the parents of any Infant children who we do find unaccompanied in the morning.

Music Lessons

KS2 children have the opportunity to learn an instrument. Lessons are provided by peripatetic music teachers who come in once a week and provide lessons during normal school time in the following:- violin, brass, woodwind and guitar (some instruments can be hired).

Lessons cost approx £5 - £5.50 per lessons and are taught in small groups. There are subsidies available and individual lessons can sometimes be taught for a higher cost.

All of the peripatetic teachers are specialist music teachers and have performed live demonstrations in school for the children over the past few weeks so they have a chance to see and hear some of the instruments.

Our Year 3&4 team played very well and got stronger and stronger as the day went on. We won two and narrowly lost one of our group games to qualify for the semi-finals, where we faced Mount Hawke. We played well but they were just too strong. This meant that we were in a third place play-off for the bronze medal. It was a fantastic game and all of our players saved their best tennis for when it mattered. In the end, we won the nail biting encounter by one point and were presented with our bronze medals. Well done to our Year 3&4s- third in the whole County!
